**Good to be back.....**  
 In 1985 when the Peace Memorial closed its doors for the last time, an association with Watford Hospital Radio ended. We began in 1955 from a broom cupboard in the Peace Memorial Hospital. The earliest programmes were recorded football commentaries from Watford's Vicarage Road ground which were played back over the hospital radio system later that evening. A live service came sometime later. During the late 60's, music was added and we continued broadcasting from a small studio on what

was then called Shrodell's Hospital. Our programmes were relayed back to the Peace Hospice via land lines. In fact we were heard at four different hospitals around the area and that does not include Hemel Hempstead hospital which was an off shoot of the Watford Hospitals Broadcasting Service.  
 On the 9th September 2009, WHR presented two internet radios to the Peace Hospice for use in the day room, meaning our programmes can once again be heard at the Peace Hospice.
